DID YOU KNOW THAT, IN FLORIDA...

SUMMARY ADMINISTRATION is a streamlined version of Probate that allows for a quicker and more efficient processing of a deceased person's Estate. It is a "shortcut" available only if: 1) The death occurred more than two years ago; or 2) the total value of the Estate is does not exceed \$75,000.00.

A **PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVE** of a **WILL** assists in the administration of an *Estate* and he/she is allowed to charge a fee for the services rendered, which is often a percentage of the gross amount of the Estate.

DEBTS incurred before marriage such as credit card debts are considered *Premarital Debts* when **DIVORCING**. If the other spouse never used the credit cards, the Court could consider those obligations as the sole responsibility of the indebted spouse.

A **DURABLE POWER OF ATTORNEY** designates an *Attorney-in-Fact* to make certain financial decisions for the incapacitated person.
