DID YOU KNOW THAT, IN FLORIDA...

A **DURABLE POWER OF ATTORNEY** designates an *Attorney-in-Fact* to make certain financial decisions for the incapacitated person, such as handling banking and stock transactions, the sale of real estate or handling tax or insurance issues.

There is no "Community Property." Courts follow the doctrine of **EQUITABLE DISTRIBUTION** when dividing marital assets. With both distribution methods, each partner walks away with some share of marital property. The difference between the two methods is *how* the Court determines each partner's share of marital property.

A **CORPORATE** name must contain the word "corporation", "company" or "incorporated" (or the abbreviation "Corp.", "Co." or "Inc.") so as to clearly delineate that it is a corporation instead of a person, partnership or other type of business entity.

A **GUARDIAN** is appointed by the Court to make decisions on behalf of a child or other incapacitated person (the **WARD**) with the Ward's best interests in mind.
